Parliament resumed last month with the issue of terrorism globally and here in Australia at the forefront of the national debate. With the most recent threats to our nation, last week the Prime Minister, the Hon Tony Abbott MP delivered an important <u>speech</u> to the Parliament on national security and the Government's approach. It's a statement I strongly support. I have been directly discussing these matters with so many people locally, please <u>email</u> me about your views on our approach to national security.

In response the Government introduced into Parliament new counterterrorism measures that will strengthen our counter-terrorism preparedness. We are providing \$630 million to support our police and security agencies with more resources to the Australian Federal Police, ASIO, ASIS and our Customs and Border Protection Service. I also moved a motion which achieved bipartisan support on behalf on the minority communities in Iraq in particular the minority Christian communities. <u>Watch this video here</u>.

This week I also took a strong stand against ABC bias and the airing of anti-Australian, anti-Western values on our national broadcaster.
