Federal Budget 2014



The Treasurer, The Hon Joe Hockey MP, delivered the Coalition Government's first Budget on 13 May 2014. This Budget is a key part of our <u>Economic Action Strategy</u> to build a strong, prosperous economy for a safe, secure Australia.

- Repairing the Budget and strengthening our economy with the implementation of the Coalitions Economic Action Strategy, debt in 2023-24 is projected to be nearly \$300 billion lower - \$389 billion as opposed to \$667 billion.
- <u>Investment in Infrastructure</u> the Government is investing a record \$50 billion in infrastructure including, <u>WestConnex</u> and <u>NorthConnex</u>.
- <u>Trade Support Loans</u> the Abbott Coalition Government is delivering on its commitment to introduce <u>Trade Support Loans</u> for apprentices to encourage more young people to take up a trade and complete their qualification.
- Long Day Care Professional Development Programme (LDCPDP) Long day care services in Mitchell can apply to share in the largest-ever investment in the professional development of their educators. Applications close 5pm (AEST) Friday 13 June 2014.
