

Last week the Liberal Party room made a decision to change our leader - with the appointment of Malcolm Turnbull as the new leader of the Federal Parliamentary Liberal Party and Prime Minister, and the reappointment of Julie Bishop as the Deputy Leader of the Liberal Party and Foreign Minister.

I would like to pay tribute to the former Prime Minister, Tony Abbott. As a party we owe him an enormous debt of gratitude for his service to the nation – particularly for the remarkable job he did in leading the Coalition to Government in 2013.

Previous experience in Treasury I bring with me to the role, from the Howard Government, having worked as an adviser to the former Assistant Treasurer and Minister for Revenue, Senator the Hon Helen Coonan and the former Parliamentary Secretary to the Treasurer, Ross Cameron.

I am looking forward to working closely with my parliamentary colleagues, the Treasurer, the Hon Scott Morrison MP and Minister for Small Business and Assistant Treasurer, the Hon Kelly O'Dwyer MP.

Stronger Communities Programme – APPLY NOW - EOI for funding closes 9 October 2015

The Mitchell Stronger Communities Programme – Round 1 is now **open**. Local community and sporting groups are invited to apply for funding for new projects.

The <u>Stronger Communities Programme</u> is to fund small capital projects which will deliver social benefits. The program aims to improve local community participation, cohesion and contribute to vibrant and viable communities.

Key aspects of the program:

 Please submit details of your <u>proposed project</u> to my office by 5pm, Friday 9 October 2015.

- Local government and incorporated not-for-profit organisations are eligible to apply.
- Grants of between \$5,000 and up to a maximum of \$20,000 are available. There is a total funding pool of \$150,000 for 2015/16 year for the Mitchell electorate.
- Applicants are required to confirm matched funding in cash or in-kind on at least a dollar-for-dollar basis.
- Following consultation, the Mitchell Stronger Communities
 Committee will provide identified applicants with access to an
 online application form. Applicants will only be able to apply for
 funding once a link to the online form has been provided by my
 office.
